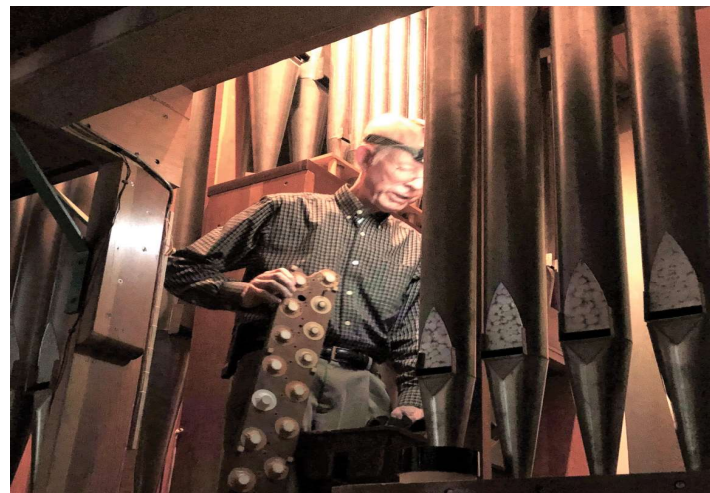
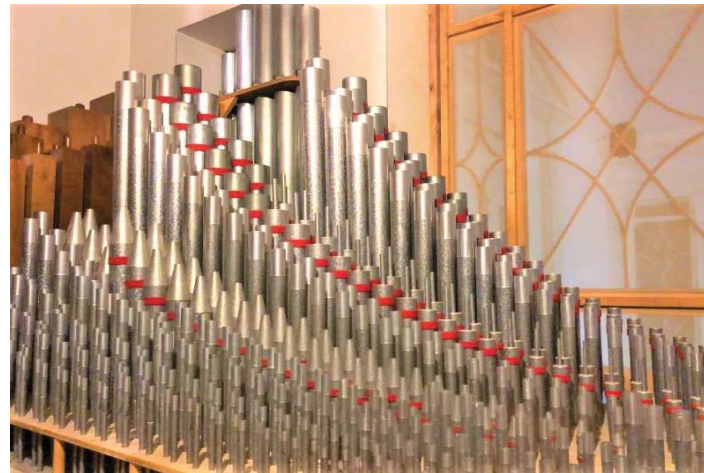


Music Notes with Pam...
