DISUCSSION GUIDE

Week 1 - The 4 Wills of God

Opening

- Welcome everyone, quick check-in.
- Share a highlight or challenge from this past week.
- Pray together: ask God to open hearts and minds to His Word.

Icebreaker

- If God texted you with His will for your life, what would you want the message to say?
- Share a time you wished God would just “make it obvious” (job, relationship, big decision, etc.).

Discovering God’s Will

Read Isaiah 46:8–10 and Proverbs 19:21

1. God’s Sovereign Will

- Big-picture plan. Unstoppable.
- Question: How does knowing God is sovereign give you peace in uncertain times?

Read 1 Thess. 4:3 and 1 Peter 1:15–16

2. God’s Moral Will

- Clear in Scripture: Be holy.
- Question: Why do we sometimes want God’s direction for the future while ignoring His instructions for today?
- What’s one area of your life where God is calling you to holiness right now?

Read 1 Corinthians 10:23 and Genesis 50:20

3. God’s Permissive Will

- Freedom to choose, even when our choices (or others') cause pain.
- Question: How have you seen God redeem a bad decision or painful situation?
- How can we avoid blaming God for things He only permits, not causes?

Read Ephesians 2:10 and Psalm 32:8

4. God's Personal Will

- God's unique calling for your life.
- Question: What does it mean to you that God prepared "good works" for you before you were even born?
- Where might God be nudging you to step out in obedience right now?

Application

- Which aspect of God's will encouraged or challenged you most this week—Sovereign, Moral, Permissive, or Personal?
- What's one step of obedience you can take this week in response?

Closing

- Remind the group: *God's will is not a puzzle to solve but a relationship to walk in.*
- Pray together:
 - Thank God for His sovereignty.
 - Ask for strength to obey His moral will.
 - Trust Him with what He permits.
 - Seek His personal calling in your life.
