But is blessed if we trust and obey.*


*But we never can prove the delights of His love

The numbers are in! There were 793 shoeboxes donated by FBC during 2025. The drop off center collected and transported a total of 2,703 shoeboxes meaning approximately 27,030 people heard the message of salvation because of the shoeboxes processed by FBC alone!

Those shoeboxes have taken the message of salvation to children and their families in the lands of Thailand, Burundi, and South Africa!

Thank you for your prayers and contributions toward this outreach. 🙏

We have already started preparing for the 2026 shoeboxes. Since it's so cold here, we are going to start by collecting winter items like hats, scarfs, gloves and mittens. These items can be hand made or purchased. Simply put them in the small box in the women's baptismal room or give them to a member of the Shoebox Team.

We are also in need of someone willing to use their sewing skills to God's glory.

Replacing our HVAC in the sanctuary....

Our HVAC system has done a fantastic job of heating, cooling and removing unwanted humidity from our beautiful sanctuary for almost 20 years. This large commercial system includes the two large compressors located outside to the right of our main entrance and the large system suspended from the ceiling to the right of the stairs leading to the attic.

Although the Trustees have been very intentional in maintaining and repairing all our HVAC systems, these large units have run their course, with one needing to be shut down in late

December and the other one running on emergency
heat as it struggles to keep the sanctuary temperature regulated.

We are asking the church family to prayerfully consider giving above and beyond their regular tithes to give what they can towards these replacements and then to have the long-term investment fund pay for any remaining balance. Although we are blessed to have this fund, it is only equivalent to three months of expenses and we would prefer not to use it.

We are also proposing that any funds used from
the long-term investment fund will be replaced through
surpluses from the general giving.


Marty Miller Memorial Fund
