It is hard to imagine that in just a few days we will be ushering in a New Year! For some of you, 2025 has been a good year, for others, 2025 has been a year full of trials, losses and disappointments, and you are ready to put this "old year" behind you. The Lord declared to the prophet Isaiah 43:18–19 (ESV), "Remember not the former things, nor consider the things of old. Behold, I am doing a new thing; now it springs forth, do you not perceive it? 

beginning February 1 at 9AM!


