DEEPER

Read: Daniel 2

1. How does prayer demonstrate our trust in God's mercy and power, especially in the face of seemingly impossible situations? Is prayer the first thing you do in a time of crisis?
2. In what ways can we cultivate a deeper reliance on prayer and trust in God's sovereignty, particularly in times of trouble?
3. Discuss how our God uses our situations and circumstances that seem impossible for both his glory and our good?
4. What do verses 19-23 tell you about how to respond to answered prayer? Do you typically respond this way? Why or why not?
5. How does Daniel 2 point to Jesus?
6. What stood out to you in this week's sermon? What were your biggest takeaways?

DISCIPLINES

Pray: Ask God to show you his mercy and to reveal his goodness. Ask the Spirit to stir in us a hope and reliance on God in times of crisis.

Read: Luke 5:12-16; Matthew 6:9-13

Write: Write down things that seem impossible in your life or the lives of others that could only be possible by God's sovereignty.

Sing: Listen to the worship songs from Sunday throughout the week. Look up the lyrics to each song and spend some time reading them as well.

Memorize: Daniel 2:20

Love: Share the gospel this week to someone who needs to hear about him.
