# LOVING PEOPLE LIKE PAUL Philippians 2:25-30

### 1. Acknowledge the strengths of others

Yet I considered it necessary to send to you Epaphroditus, my brother, fellow worker, and fellow soldier, but your messenger and the one who ministered to my need; (25)

## 2. Accept the distinctions of others

since he was longing for you all, and was distressed because you had heard that he was sick. (26)

## 3. Affirm the worth of others

For indeed he was sick almost unto death; but God had mercy on him, and not only on him but on me also, lest I should have sorrow upon sorrow. Therefore I sent him the more eagerly, that when you see him again you may rejoice, and I may be less sorrowful. (27-28)

## 4. Appreciate the sacrifices of others

Receive him therefore in the Lord with all gladness, and hold such men in esteem; because for the work of Christ he came close to death, not regarding his life, to supply what was lacking in your service toward me. (29-30)
