The Holy Spirit manifests Himself in believers in 2 ways: **power** and **fruit**. *I Corinthians 12 – 13*

POWER:

God gives believers spiritual gifts. I Corinthians 12:4; Romans 12:6-8

1. Prophecy 2. Ministry 3. Teaching 4. Exhortation 5. Giving 6. Leadership 7. Mercy

God gives believers spiritual ministries. I Corinthians 12:5; Ephesians 4:11-13

1. Apostles 2. Prophets 3. Evangelists 4. Pastors 5. Teachers

God gives believers spiritual activities (workings). I Corinthians 12:6-10

-These *energema* are not the spiritual gifts but are spiritual manifestations empowering us to minister in a specific situation. These are demonstrated in scripture in the lives of Jesus and/or the Apostles.

FRUIT:

The fruit of the Spirit is **love**. *Galatians 5:22-23*

Love is manifested in:

1. Joy 2. Peace 3. Patience 4. Kindness, 5. Goodness 6. Faithfulness 7. Gentleness 8. Self control

Power without love is **<u>useless</u>**. *I Corinthians* 13:1-2

Like God's power, the Holy Spirit's fruit in my life does not come about through human effort or energy.

Spiritual fruit can only be produced by **<u>abiding</u>** in Christ. John 15:1-5
