

GOD'S AMAZING GRACE
Genesis 6

1. God shows grace through time, don't procrastinate

Then the LORD said, "My Spirit shall not abide in man forever, for he is flesh: his days shall be 120 years. (3)

2. God shows grace through people, listen to them

So the LORD said, "I will blot out man whom I have created from the face of the land, man and animals and creeping things and birds of the heavens, for I am sorry that I have made them." But Noah found favor in the eyes of the LORD. (7-8)

if he did not spare the ancient world, but preserved Noah, a herald of righteousness... (2 Peter 2:5)

3. God shows grace through visible signs, heed them

And God said to Noah, "I have determined to make an end of all flesh, for the earth is filled with violence through them. Behold, I will destroy them with the earth. Make yourself an ark of gopher wood. (13-14)

4. God shows grace through covenants, believe them

For behold, I will bring a flood of waters upon the earth to destroy all flesh in which is the breath of life under heaven. Everything that is on the earth shall die. But I will establish my covenant with you, and you shall come into the ark, you, your sons, your wife, and your sons' wives with you. And of every living thing of all flesh, you shall bring two of every sort into the ark to keep them alive with you. They shall be male and female. (17-19)

5. God shows grace through instructions, obey them

Noah did this; he did all that God commanded him. (22)
