Slide 1: EXODUS: 13:1-22 : Remember What the Lord Has Done

Slide 2: Main Point: Salvation is only possible by the mighty loving hand of God.

Slide 3:

1. The Sign for Their Remembrance - The Feast of Unleavened Bread (v 13:3-10)

Slide 4: Phylactery (13:9) *9 It shall be as a sign to you on your hand and as a memorial between your eyes, that the Lord's law may be in your mouth; for with a strong hand the Lord has brought you out of Egypt.*

Slide 5:

a. Side Note: Unleavened Bread in the Bible (not all of them)

Genesis 19:1-3 Unleavened Bread in Sodom - Lot bakes unleavened bread for the two angels before their deliverance

Exodus 12:39: Unleavened bread - represents the speed at which the LORD rescued His People

Luke 22:19-20 Unleavened Bread: The feast the disciples and Jesus are observing during the Last Supper.

1 Corinthians 5:6-8 Unleavened Bread - represents a cleansed church and cleansed heart from sin.

2. A Sign for Their Unique Separation: The Law of the Firstborn (v 13:11-16)

- a. Mary and Joseph, after the birth of Christ: Obey God's command. (Luke 2:22-24)

- b. Romans 12:1-2 - A living Sacrifice - as a born again believer and child of God.

- 3. **Signs for the Lord's guidance. The Wilderness Way: (v 13:17-22).**
 - a. Christ the way, the perfect way, the only way, the truth and the life (John 14:6)
 - b. To recuse a people for Himself and for His glory (1 Peter 2:9-10)
