PRACTICAL WAYS TO ENCOURAGE OTHERS Acts 18:18-28

1. Give others your time

So Paul still remained a good while. (18)

2. Be physically with others

Then he took leave of the brethren and sailed for Syria, and Priscilla and Aquila were with him. (18)

3. Include others in your schedule

And when he had landed at Caesarea, and gone up and greeted the church, he went down to Antioch. After he had spent some time there, he departed and went over the region of Galatia and Phrygia in order, strengthening all the disciples. (22-23)

4. Lovingly and privately correct others when they are wrong

So he began to speak boldly in the synagogue. When Aquila and Priscilla heard him, they took him aside and explained to him the way of God more accurately. (26)

5. Use your influence to help others

And when he desired to cross to Achaia, the brethren wrote, exhorting the disciples to receive him; and when he arrived, he greatly helped those who had believed through grace; (27)

6. Serve Jesus enthusiastically

for he vigorously refuted the Jews publicly, showing from the Scriptures that Jesus is the Christ. (28)
