THE PROMISE IN PHILIPPIANS 4:19:

- 1. God knows my needs**
- 2. God can meet my needs**

IF THIS IS TRUE, WHY ARE MY NEEDS NOT BEING MET?

1. He is not my God

But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name: John 1:12

2. I have confused needs with wants

Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought... Romans 8:26

3. I am unwilling to do what God says

For even when we were with you, we commanded you this: If anyone will not work, neither shall he eat. 2 Thessalonians 3:10

4. I never asked

... you do not have because you do not ask. James 4:2

5. God is growing or testing me

My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials, knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience. James 1:2-3

6. My priorities are misplaced

But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you. Matthew 6:33
