# A Word About Worry Philippians 4:6-7

### 1. Christians are not to worry about anything.

Be anxious for nothing... (v. 6a)

In *Luke 12:22-32* Jesus gives 3 reasons why worry is unnecessary:

I have no control <u>ultimately</u>. (v. 25-26)

God is in control completely. (v. 24, 27-28)

God loves me passionately. (v. 32)

#### 2. Christians are to respond to worry with <u>prayer</u>.

...but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known unto God... (v. 6b)

## 3. Christians are guaranteed peace when responding to worry with prayer.

And the peace of God which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. (v.7)

Question: If I'm not to worry, why does God allow worrisome situations?

# Answer: To conform me into the image of Christ!
