# The Empowering of the Holy Spirit

## **Lesson 3 - The controversy surrounding the Holy Spirit in our lives**

The controversy surrounding the Holy Spirit revolves around at least two major issues:

- 1.) **Abuse** of the manifestations of the Holy Spirit
- 2.) **Overreaction** to the abuse of the Holy Spirit

Abuse of the Holy Spirit results from trusting experiences **over** God's Word.

Overreaction to the abuse occurs when we discount experiences **in spite of** God's Word.

Specifically, the greatest issue concerns the manifestation of tongues (languages). Paul addresses proper use of these Holy Spirit manifestations in I Corinthians 14.

### **Tongues are:**

- **1.) Prayer** *I Cor.* 14:2
- 2.) Not understood by others I Cor. 14:2
- 3.) Edifying to the one praying I Cor. 14:4
- 4.) Desirable for all I Cor. 14:5
- 5.) Beneficial in group setting with an interpreter I Cor. 14:5
- 6.) No benefit in group setting w/o an interpreter I Cor. 14:6-11
- 7.) Me praying (my spirit) I Cor. 14:14
- 8.) Not understood by me (my mind) I Cor. 14:14
- 9.) Primarily for personal use I Cor. 14:15-19
- **10.) Praise and thanksgiving to God** *I Cor.* 14:16-17
- 11.) A cause of tremendous damage when misused I Cor. 4:23

### **Tongues are not:**

- 1.) Me speaking to men from God I Cor. 14:2
- 2.) Me praying for men or situations as God leads I Cor. 14:16-17
- **3.) Beyond my control** *I Cor.* 14:15; 27-28

#### **Conclusion:**

In the church setting God prioritizes **prophecy** (proclaiming His Word) so all can learn, be encouraged and built up in the faith.

Tongues are only beneficial in church if done **orderly** and with an **interpreter** so all can understand.

The primary use of tongues is in **private devotion** to bless God with praise and thanksgiving.

The primary benefit of tongues is **personal edification** as your spirit blesses God by the power of the Holy Spirit.
