The Spiritual Realm - Lesson 6: The Multidimensionality of Jesus

Comparisons Between Our 3-D Reality and a Computer-Generated Reality

1. Both Are Built on Information

Computer Reality. Everything—objects, textures, physics, interactions—is made of code (1s and 0s).

Our Reality. Quantum physics shows that matter is not solid but made of information, probabilities, and quantized states.

Comparison: Both worlds are *information-based*, not substance-based.

2. Both Use Discrete Units (Pixels/Quanta)

Computer Reality. A digital world is made of pixels or polygons—tiny units that cannot be divided further.

Our Reality. The universe is built from indivisible quanta: photons, electrons, Planck-scale "space pixels".

Comparison: Both realities are quantized, not continuous.

3. Both Follow Hard-Coded Rules

Computer Reality. Every interaction is determined by programmed physics: gravity settings, collision rules, behavior scripts.

Our Reality. The cosmos follows fixed, fine-tuned physical constants: speed of light, gravity constant, electron mass, strong & weak nuclear forces.

Comparison: Both systems operate according to precise, unchanging rules—like a program with fixed parameters.

4. Both Have Maximum Speeds and Limits

Computer Reality. A simulation has: maximum processing speed, frame rate limits, resolution limits. **Our Reality.** Nature has: a maximum speed (speed of light), minimum length (Planck length), minimum time interval (Planck time).

Comparison: Both systems have built-in speed and resolution limits.

5. Both Worlds Require an External Source of Power

Computer Reality. If you unplug the computer, the simulated world ceases instantly.

Our Reality. Physics shows the universe requires continuous "input": Quantum fields must be sustained, Laws remain constant moment to moment, Energy can neither appear nor sustain itself.

Comparison: Both depend on an outside source to continue existing.

6. Both Separate the "Programmer" From the "Environment"

Computer Reality. A programmer exists *outside* the digital world, in a higher dimension.

Our Reality. Scripture describes God as: spirit, eternal, outside space and time, yet interacting with our world.

Comparison: A higher-dimensional Being can interact with a lower-dimensional reality.

7. Both Reveal the Necessity of a Programmer/Creator

Computer Reality. A simulation cannot write itself. It requires: intelligence, intention, design, purpose.

Our Reality. The digital-like structure of the universe points to: Mind, Intelligence, Consciousness, Intentional design.

Comparison: A digital universe implies a Designer, just as a simulated world implies a programmer.

Jesus and the sin-virus

If one were to describe the world a person lives in as digital, then sin entering would be like a computer virus taking root in the three-dimensional world, affecting all that is within it. God decided to enter the universe Himself to save people from the sin-virus, so He entered the three-dimensional world as Jesus Christ.

A new genealogy: Jesus as the last Adam

Mankind's bloodline was corrupt. The sin-virus corrupted humanity's spiritual existence, and it even affected their physical existence.

Everyone, that is, except Jesus Christ (2 Corinthians 5:21; Hebrews 7:26).

God chose to enter the world as the new or last Adam, a perfect man.

1 Corinthians 15:45 Thus it is written, 'The first man Adam became a living being'; the last Adam became a life-giving spirit.

Jesus had perfect blood, untainted by sin.

A person must be born again—not born of the first Adam, but born of the last Adam, Jesus Christ, God in the flesh.

John 3:3–7 Jesus answered him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again he cannot see the kingdom of God." Nicodemus said to him, "How can a man be born when he is old? Can he enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born?" Jesus answered, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God. That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. Do not marvel that I said to you, 'You must be born again'.

Jesus as evidence of a higher dimension - The incarnation of Jesus Christ

If there was any doubt as to whether Jesus was God before being born in Bethlehem, John overrules it in the first few verses of his gospel account.

John 1:1–3 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things were made through him, and without him was not any thing made that was made.

John 1:14 And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.

Sent by the Father, born of a woman

Galatians 4:4 But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth his Son, born of woman, born under the law.

1 Timothy 3:16 Great indeed, we confess, is the mystery of godliness: He was manifested in the flesh, vindicated by the Spirit, seen by angels, proclaimed among the nations, believed on in the world, taken up in glory.

The virgin birth and the mystery of the God-man

Matthew 1:18 Now the birth of Jesus Christ took place in this way. When his mother Mary had been betrothed to Joseph, before they came together she was found to be with child from the Holy Spirit. The Creator of the universe made His entrance into the digital, three-dimensional universe of mankind, and the world celebrates this event at Christmas every December 25th.

The life of Jesus Christ: fully human, fully God

A. Evidence of Jesus' humanity

Jesus grew, just as any young child would grow in an earthly body.

Luke 2:52 And Jesus increased in wisdom and in stature and in favor with God and man.

Jesus displayed hunger.

Matthew 4:2 And after fasting forty days and forty nights, he was hungry.

Jesus displayed thirst.

John 19:28 After this, Jesus, knowing that all was now finished, said (to fulfill the Scripture), "I thirst".

Jesus became physically tired.

John 4:6 Jacob's well was there; so Jesus, wearied as he was from his journey, was sitting beside the well. It was about the sixth hour.

Jesus displayed sorrow by crying.

John 11:35 Jesus wept.

B. Evidence of Jesus' deity

Jesus claimed to exist from eternity past. **John 8:58** Jesus said to them, 'Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was, I am'.

Jesus received and did not refuse worship due only to God.

Matthew 2:11 And going into the house, they saw the child with Mary his mother, and they fell down and worshiped him. Then, opening their treasures, they offered him gifts, gold and frankincense and myrrh.

Matthew 8:2–3 And behold, a leper came to him and knelt before him, saying, 'Lord, if you will, you can make me clean.' And Jesus stretched out his hand and touched him, saying, 'I will; be clean.' And immediately his leprosy was cleansed.

Jesus claims to be God and has authority over the Sabbath.

Matthew 12:8 For the Son of Man is lord of the Sabbath.

Jesus is recognized as God by the demons.

Mark 1:24 What have you to do with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know who you are—the Holy One of God.

Jesus forgave sins. The Pharisees understood that only God could do that.

Luke 5:20–25 And when he saw their faith, he said, 'Man, your sins are forgiven you.' And the scribes and the Pharisees began to question, saying, 'Who is this who speaks blasphemies? Who can forgive sins but God alone?' When Jesus perceived their thoughts, he answered them, 'Why do you question in your hearts? Which is easier, to say, "Your sins are forgiven you," or to say, "Rise and walk"? But that you may know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins'—he said to the man who was paralyzed—'I say to you, rise, pick up your bed and go home.' And immediately he rose up before them and picked up what he had been lying on and went home, glorifying God.

C. Jesus' miracles as multidimensional signs

Jesus performed various miracles during His three years of ministry to proclaim and demonstrate that He was indeed God in the flesh.

All of these miracles were intentionally directed at showing He had power over the curse of sin on mankind and the world.

Sickness, death, working for food, and destructive weather all result from sin entering the physical world in Genesis chapter three.

Jesus, in order to prove He was the creator of the three-dimensional world, performed acts not governed by the dimensional rules or laws of the physical world.

The death and resurrection of Jesus Christ

Jesus confined Himself to specific rules and laws in His human body of flesh, but His resurrected body was governed by a new set of rules and laws.

John 20:24–29 Now Thomas, one of the twelve, called the Twin, was not with them when Jesus came. 25 So the other disciples told him, "We have seen the Lord." But he said to them, "Unless I see in his hands the mark of the nails, and place my finger into the mark of the nails, and place my hand into his side, I will never believe." 26 Eight days later, his disciples were inside again, and Thomas was with them. Although the doors were locked, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you." 27 Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here, and see my hands; and put out your hand, and place it in my side. Do not disbelieve, but believe." 28 Thomas answered him, "My Lord and my God!" 29 Jesus said to him, "Have you believed because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed."

Luke 24:30–31 When he was at table with them, he took the bread and blessed and broke it and gave it to them. And their eyes were opened, and they recognized him. And he vanished from their sight.

The ascension: Jesus returns to the higher dimension - Acts 1:9-11
