UNDERSTANDING OUR GREATEST ENEMY Genesis 3

1. Satan <u>deceives</u>

Now the serpent was more crafty than any other beast of the field that the Lord God had made. (1)

2. Satan <u>doubts</u>

He said to the woman, "Did God actually say, 'You shall not eat of any tree in the garden'?" (1)

3. Satan <u>defies</u>

But the serpent said to the woman, "You will not surely die." (4)

4. Satan <u>denies</u>

But the serpent said to the woman, "You will not surely die. For God knows that when you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil." (4-5)

5. Satan divides

Then the eyes of both were opened, and they knew that they were naked. And they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves loincloths. (7)

6. Satan <u>destroys</u>

And they heard the sound of the Lord God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and the man and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the Lord God among the trees of the garden. (8)

7. Satan <u>is defeated</u>

"I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and her offspring; he shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise his heel." (15)
