Proverbs 4:20-27

Four Questions to Guard Your Heart

1. Who are you listening to?

My son, be attentive to my words; incline your ear to my sayings. Let them not escape from your sight; keep them within your heart. For they are life to those who find them, and healing to all their flesh. (20-22)

2. What are you saying?

Put away from you crooked speech, and put devious talk far from you. (24)

3. Where are you looking?

Let your eyes look directly forward, and your gaze be straight before you. (25)

4. Which way are your feet taking you?

Ponder the path of your feet; then all your ways will be sure. Do not swerve to the right or to the left; turn your foot away from evil. (26-27)

Sermon Takeaways

1. If your heart isn't fed with God's truth, it will feast on the world's lies.

2. If you don't set your direction, you'll drift into destruction.

3. If you don't follow Jesus, your heart will chase something else.
