THE TRUTH ABOUT ASSURANCE 1 John 3:19-24

If you are doubting your salvation, ask yourself these questions:

1. Do I trust God more than my feelings?

By this we shall know that we are of the truth and reassure our heart before him; for whenever our heart condemns us, God is greater than our heart, and he knows everything. Beloved, if our heart does not condemn us, we have confidence before God; (19-21)

2. Do I pray with boldness?

and whatever we ask we receive from him... (22)

3. Do I desire to obey God's Word?

and whatever we ask we receive from him, because we keep his commandments... (22)

4. Do I seek to please Christ?

and whatever we ask we receive from him, because we keep his commandments and do what pleases him. (22)

5. Is my faith in Christ alone?

And this is his commandment, that we believe in the name of his Son Jesus Christ... (23)

6. Do I love other Christians?

And this is his commandment, that we believe in the name of his Son Jesus Christ and love one another, just as he has commanded us. (23)

7. Is the **Holy Spirit active in my life?**

Whoever keeps his commandments abides in God, and God in him. And by this we know that he abides in us, by the Spirit whom he has given us. (24)
