

HABITS OF HIGHLY EFFECTIVE SPIRITUAL LEADERS
1 Thessalonians 2:6-12

1. They don't keep score

Nor did we seek glory from men, either from you or from others, when we might have made demands as apostles of Christ. (6)

2. They act like adults

But we were gentle among you, just as a nursing mother cherishes her own children. So, affectionately longing for you, we were well pleased to impart to you not only the gospel of God, but also our own lives, because you had become dear to us. (7-8)

3. They work hard

For you remember, brethren, our labor and toil; for laboring night and day, that we might not be a burden to any of you, we preached to you the gospel of God. (9)

4. They live what they preach

You are witnesses, and God also, how devoutly and justly and blamelessly we behaved ourselves among you who believe; (10)

5. They motivate others

as you know how we exhorted, and comforted, and charged every one of you, as a father does his own children, (11)

6. They point people to Jesus

that you would walk worthy of God who calls you into His own kingdom and glory. (12)
