

Good Grace *Acts 11:1-18*

1. Grace is the Christian's greatest gift.

"Now the apostles and brethren who were in Judea heard that the Gentiles had also received the word of God." (1)

2. You are often misunderstood when you share the message of grace.

And when Peter came up to Jerusalem, those of the circumcision contended with him, saying, "You went in to uncircumcised men and ate with them!" (2-3)

3. Stories of grace are the best answer to criticism.

But Peter explained it to them in order from the beginning, saying... If therefore God gave them the same gift as He gave us when we believed on the Lord Jesus Christ, who was I that I could withstand God?" (4,17)

4. Grace is a person and his name is Jesus.

When they heard these things they became silent; and they glorified God, saying, "Then God has also granted to the Gentiles repentance to life." (18)
