Matthew 6:5-15 Fall Forward: Prayer

Highlights

- In life you will fall. When you fall, FALL FORWARD.
 - Trying to live out your life with Jesus is hard, you will stumble, even fail sometimes. But when you do, keep moving toward Jesus.
- How do you fall forward? Spiritual Disciplines.
 - Practices put in place to help us journey toward Jesus, whether we are "feeling it" or not.
- **v. 5** Hypocrite Jesus is using this word differently than we do today. It shouldn't point to someone else, but point us to ourselves to examine our hearts.
 - Literally means play actor: putting on an image that isn't really the person
 - You say..... but I say..... from Matthew 5. God sees who we really are, even if we look okay on the outside. Who does God really see, when He sees you?
 - The hypocritical part of me just wants people to believe I am _____. (Fill in the blank)
- **v. 6** "...but when you pray, go into your **(inner) room**...." Inner room is the hidden place (in your heart) where only Jesus sees; only Jesus has access.
 - Maybe Jesus mentioned the inner room to reflect or make us think of the Holy of Holies in the Temple.
 - The very place God resides
 - Through Jesus, the very presence of God residing inside us
 - The Holy of Holies was hidden by a veil, that tore when Jesus died on the cross, giving us access to God; it is no longer veiled.
 - I can be in the same space with God; I become that space.
 - How does thinking of yourself as the Holy of Holies; the inner room where you are to go pray, change the way you pray? How does it change the way you think about prayer?
 - Do you have a literal prayer closet?
 - V. 7-8 Why does God hear me when I pray?
 - Not because I say the right words or pray long enough, etc.
 - It's because God is your Father. You belong to Him, He cares of you.
 - Have you ever thought about God actually hearing your prayer? Have you ever wondered how He does it?
 - What keeps you from praying, if anything?
- **V.9** <u>Our</u> Father... we are not meant to do this alone. God is the Father of all believers. Because of the relationship we have with Him, we don't have to pray in isolation.
 - Your <u>name</u> = character
 - <u>Hallowed</u> or <u>honored</u> = acknowledging who God has been in our lives and in history
 - Your Kingdom = I could build my own little kingdom that I control, but it is God's.
 - We have to lay down our kingdom for his
 - When we try to build our own kingdom, we spin our wheels, we never have enough.
 - Submitting to God's kingdom = life
 - <u>Will</u> when we fix our eyes on His Character, His will <u>will</u> be done. Heaven comes to earth.

- What do you see in the first part of the Lord's prayer?
- V.11 Jesus sustains us, He abundantly has enough for us. Jesus has overcome temptation.
- V. 14-15 (See the parable of the Unmerciful Servant in Matthew 18:21-35)
 - Jesus sees you're forgiving others, even if it's for something small
 - Jesus gives you the capacity to forgive others when Jesus's forgiveness is real to you.
 - I will forgive because I have been forgiven it's a supernatural thing!
 - Is His grace and forgiveness real to you? Why or why not?
 - Who do you need to forgive?

Does Jesus's forgiveness affect the way you pray? How?

Summary points:

- God sees you as no one else does.
- God is anywhere you are. The veil is torn.
- God hears you because He is your Father.
- You get to experience all of this because of His forgiveness.

What do we do with this?

- Invite Jesus to see and speak to the real you.
- Consider who you should forgive.
- Remember the Lord's prayer when you get stuck.
