Highlights

- Luke 15:1 Tax collectors were traitors, enemies of the Jews
 - If the message of Jesus isn't available to the sinners and tax collectors, should we be a part of it??
- Luke 15:2 The Pharisees were not there to listen, but to chat among themselves
 - They are saying those sinners and tax collectors are unclean.
 - In the OT, you have to GET clean to approach God
 - In the NT, Jesus will COME to the unclean, and bring holiness to them
 - Are the unclean worthy of hearing the teachings of God?
 - **Parable** a simple story of common themes to teach about God's Kingdom and His character
 - This parable is directed to the Pharisees, but everyone heard it; everyone can learn from it.
- Luke 15:4 Sheep were not shepherd's pets, they were their livelihood
 - Sheep get lost easily and they don't find their way back
 - Sheep cannot defend themselves: not only from predators, but from nature (rocks, bugs, etc.)
 - Sheep will eat anything including poisonous plants
 - The one sheep who wandered off has not chance to survive by itself.
 - Sheep need a shepherd.
- We are sheep and we need a shepherd! See John 10:11, 14-15.
 - Jesus knows His sheep!
 - Jesus is actively searching for His sheep because He knows them.
 - This wandering one isn't a random sheep. The shepherd KNOWS it.
 - Jesus knows YOU.
- Luke 15:5-6 When the shepherd finds the sheep, it is comfortable on his shoulders because he knows it and it knows the shepherd.
 - The sheep is worth it to go after it.
 - YOU are worth it for the Great Shepherd (Jesus) to go after.
 - Did Jesus leave all the FOLLOWERS to go after the LOST?
 - We ALL have been lost sheep.
 - And at some point you were lost again.
 - Don't look at yourself and think you are part of the 99!!!
 - If you've ever been found you were carried.
 - And you're still being carried.
 - You are known
- God is coming for you, to CARRY you. He sees you and knows what you're going through.
- This is a story about the JOY of the shepherd.
 - Jesus has been filled with joy because He found you and carried you. And He is celebrating with all of heaven.
- Luke 15:7 Doesn't everyone need to repent? Yes, but he's talking to and about the Pharisees who THINK they don't need to repent.
 - They think they are fine the 99.
 - The one who wandered off KNOWS he's lost.

- We are all the one and Jesus is putting us all on His back.
 - If you were lost, never forget you were the one.
 - If you are still lost, Jesus is actively searching for you.
 - The day we surrender our life and direction to Jesus is a day of joy for all of heaven.

Car Conversations

- If you had 100 sheep, would you leave to go find one lost one?
- Why do you think the shepherd did that?
- Do you know Jesus cares about you like He cares for sheep?

See Luke 19 – the story of Zaccheus

- Jesus saw Z, he knows Z, he wants to be with Z
- Luke 19:9-10, Salvation has come to this house: Jesus is saying Z is part of the family!

Today is the day Jesus sees you and brings you home – into the family.

- You don't have to be lost any longer
- Today is the day of salvation for you!
