Highlights

- James writes about what it means to have faith and put it into action; and what it means to put faith and action together to gain wisdom.
- v.1-3 "among you" = the church
 - o kill/covet commandments 6 and 10 (See Exodus 20)
 - Not really killing, see Matthew 5:21-22
 - We don't pray!
 - We don't live a life of prayer. We pray when we think about it.
 - We do our own thing and put prayer into it.
 - Are you in constant contact with the Father?
 - What would it look like for you to be in constant contact with God?
 - We pray selfishly. That's why you don't get what you want and that's why we fight.
 - We want what we want when we want it. If God doesn't give it, we take it.
 - Do you have a it's better to ask for forgiveness than permission in your relationship with God?
- v. 4 adultery commandment 7
 - Friendship with the world means embracing living the way the world lives.
 - It does not mean you can't be friends with people who don't know Jesus.
 - God put His Spirit in us and He jealously wants to interact with us.
 - The conflict between relationship with God and friendship with the world is what causes adultery. It's like we're cheating on God with the world.
 - How do you cheat on God?
 - You may be an enemy of God but He still offers you His grace.
 - You may have an enemy, but God still desires that you offer His grace.
 - By offering HIS grace to others, you are letting go of the chains of unforgiveness
 - It's okay to love people from far away.
 - See Matthew 5:43-45a Jesus taught the same thing
- v.7-10 Our faith requires action
 - We have an active role in our faith journey. What does that look like in your journey. What does it mean to have an active role?
 - You have the ability and power to resist the devil because the Holy Spirit lives in you.
 - If you're not growing, it's on you, not God. Are you growing? If not, what are you
 going to change to have an active role. It's not about checking off the boxes, it's an
 active role.
 - God also has an active role (He will come near to you, He will lift you up)
- v. 11-12 When you kill/covet/commit adultery, you are judging the law. Only God can judge.
 - o Who are you to judge your neighbor?
- v. 13-14 What does it mean to be a mist?
 - Mist falls back to the ground, vapor rises
 - o Sometimes life is so good we forget how short it really is.
 - It's like it never happened
 - Our lives are a mist, but the decisions we make in the mist are eternal.
 - There are others around us, too, who are in the same situation.

- v. 15-16 Stop acting like you have your life under control.
 - You don't determine your future
 - o Our lives are in His hands.
 - It's okay to plan but you're not in control
 - We make plans but we hold on to our life loosely
 - We have to live differently: one way is generosity with time, resources, etc.
 - Generosity leads us to not hold on too tight.
- v. 17 If its clear to you and you do it anyway, it's sin.
 - When I sin, it makes me an enemy of God, but God gives us more grace.

So what do I do now?

- **1. How's your prayer life?** Is it part of the way you live life?
- 2. Have you stopped to consider the grace God extended to you? See Romans 5:6-8
- 3. Who is not receiving the undeserving grace and love that God extended to you?
 - a. Who are you not extending grace to even though God is happy to give it to you?
- 4. Are you resisting the devil?
 - a. Are you journeying toward Jesus?
- 5. Are you holding onto this world too tightly?
- 6. Are you living generously?

As we become fully dependent on the Lord, the way we pray, treat others, see future and give generously will never be the same.

Who does your life belong to? You or Jesus?
