SERMON OUTLINE

I must choose to...

1. Remain dependent on the Grace of Christ (vs. 6-7).
2. Confront false teaching instead of ignoring it (vs. 8-9).
3. Please God over man (v. 10).

Big Idea: Increasing our dependance on Christ strengthens our loyalty to the Gospel
