Romans 6:1-11

What Really Changed? – Part 1

What did the gospel really change about you?

SERMON OUTLINE

1. You died to sin with Christ. (vs. 2, 6-7)
2. You were buried in baptism with Christ. (vs. 3-4a)
3. You have been given a new life with Christ. (vs. 4-5, 8-11)

Big Idea: Personally knowing the gospel enables you to practically live the gospel.

1. REVIEW

1. When we personally know the gospel, what happens to our relationship with sin? Explain. (vs. 2, 6-7)

2. What does it mean when Paul writes that we are baptized into Jesus's death? (vs. 3-4a)

3. What does new life, "alive to God in Christ Jesus," look like? (vs. 4-5, 8-11)

2. ASSESS

1. Since you first came to personally know the gospel, how has your new life looked? How has the Lord changed you?

3. APPLY

1. What area of your life do you need to surrender to the gospel to live more practically for Christ? What could/should this look like?

4. 4Ws: WORSHIP

1. How does personally knowing the gospel stir worship in your heart? What part of the this scripture cultivates increased worship for you this week?
