SERMON OUTLINE

REVIEW
What does Paul mean when he says "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ" in verse 3?
As you read verse 4, Paul shifts to tell us that God has "chosen us" to be in Christ before the foundation of the world. (The Doctrine of Election). This teaching is seen throughout the entire bible and has for centuries baffled the minds of every great Theologian. Read these Scriptures, Romans 8:29; Romans 9: 1-33; 1 Thess. 1:4-5; John 6:37; John 13:18; Acts 4:27-28; 1 Peter 1:2; Acts 2:23; etc. How does this truth encourage you to know that God has always wanted and desired for you to be His child?
Read Ephesians 1:4 and 2 Peter 3:9. What are the three responses/ impacts the Doctrine of Election should cause when we dwell on it?
In verses 5-6, Paul guides us toward the goodness of God as seen through His adopting us into His family. How should this truth shape our identity?

Which one of the three responses toward Election do you sense needs to grow more in your heart and life? (Humility, Godliness, Urgency) Why do you think this?
What action will you take this week to remind yourself of the goodness of God?
