Established Without Compromise

Where you are does not excuse who you become.

Point #1 · Rev. 2:12

His Word Establishes Us

Jesus speaks with authority.

The Word of God is not just here to make you feel better; it is here to make you right.

"These things saith he which hath the sharp sword with two edges..."

Point #2 · Rev. 2:13

Faithful in a Hostile Culture

God sees your faithfulness.

Faithfulness is not proven in comfort; it is proven under pressure.

You can live in a dark culture and still shine

"I know thy works, and where thou dwellest, even where Satan's seat is..." (v.13)

The Danger of Compromise

You can be faithful in public and compromised in private.

They were holding: Doctrine of Balaam → mixing truth with sin

Doctrine of Nicolaitans → tolerated immorality

Not open rebellion...Tolerated compromise.

What are we tolerating that God is confronting?

"But I have a few things against thee..."

Repent and Be Restored

God does not expose to shame you.

He exposes to restore you.

“Repent...” · “To him that overcometh...”

We are not called to blend in.

We are called to be built by God and rooted to last.
