GROWING DEEPER

Engage

Share a story of a time when you stepped out of your comfort zone (e.g., a different country, culture, or new language). What were some of the major similarities and differences? How did you view your home after spending time in another culture? What were some of the biggest takeaways you learned from your cross-cultural experiences?

Explore

Read Acts 10:34-43. Why does it matter that God shows no partiality? How has this event transformed our world? How would you explain the main points of Peter's gospel message in your own words?

Read Acts 10:44-48. Why were Jewish Christians astonished that Gentiles were filled with the Holy Spirit? What does this passage teach us about human nature and God's grace?

Read Acts 11:1-17. What is the connection between Peter's vision and the Gentile's invitation? Peter says to the believers in Jerusalem, "who was I that I could stand in God's way?" Because God's idea is to integrate his church, how is a multi-cultural church a witness to the power of the Gospel?

Apply

Seeing that God shows no partiality and his heart is for an integrated church, what implications should that have for God's people? How might we be tempted to show partiality (education, income, success, ethnicity, personality, etc.)? Where in your life do you drift towards homogeny? What are some practical ways we can guard our hearts against showing partiality and seeking comfort in what is familiar? How can we labor for a more diverse Church?


