
## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

- 1. As Christ-followers, part of our identity is that of a freed slave. Christ has broken sin's enslavement through His death and resurrection. Though we are free, sin still has an effect over us. In what ways does sin still effect you today?
- 2. The Gospel, clearly communicated, is a beautiful illustration of God's love freeing His people from death afforded to us by our sin nature. Paul warns the Galatian believers about adding anything to the Gospel. As we see in Galatians 5:2-6, it's the necessity of circumcision in question. Is there, or has there been an issue that has held you back from believing in the Gospel? What is it? What is the Gospel? How can we ensure that we're not adding anything to the Gospel?
- 3. We can often misunderstand or use our freedom as a license to do what we want. How do Paul's words in Titus 2:11-14 communicate grace as an instrument through which God aligns our desires with His plan? How do these words need to be applied to your life?
- 4. Jesus offers complete forgiveness and freedom from our sin. What do Jesus' words in John 8:31-35 say to you? How does this image change how you see yourself and your place in God's kingdom?
- 5. What is the difference from our obedience flowing from our identity rather than defining it?
- 6. What truth is God speaking to you about your identity? Where do you need to live-gout that truth about yourself?
