SHARED EXPERIENCES

EXPERIENCE A: PRACTICE CONFESSION WITH GOD EVERY NIGHT

Reflect upon Psalm 139:23-24. Ask God if there is anything that may need to be confessed from your day. Embrace the forgiveness given by God, and ask that God may lead you to see victory in that area of your life tomorrow.

EXPERIENCE B: ASSESS RELATIONSHIPS AND BEGIN PRAYING FOR RECONCILIATION

Jesus stresses in His teaching that unity amongst His people is imperative (Matthew 5:23-24). Is there anyone in your life that you may need to make amends with and seek foregiveness from? Before coming to worship next Sunday, begin praying for reconciliation, and reach out to that individual.

EXPERIENCE C: TRUST ONE PERSON WITH A CONFESSION

Sometimes it is best to confess our sins to a friend or other trusted individual who may help bear the burden (Galatians 6:1), pray for you, and remind you of God's assurance of forgiveness. It may need to be the person that our sin has affected. Be careful with this, as confession is meant to restore relationships - not hurt or damage them.
