4. Read Jeremiah 29:1-14. Describe what has happened, to the best of your knowledge at this point in the life and history of God's people. Who does Jeremiah address his message to? Why is their situation so significant? What might the exiles be thinking about?
5. In verses 5-9, Jeremiah outlines a pattern of living in exile. What does Jeremiah encourage the exiles to do?

6. What are some common views Christians have about our cities here in the Portland Metro area?
7. As Christians, how do we resist the extremes of fundamentalism (avoid the city) or progressivism (become like the city)? Using this scale, which side do you tend to feel more comfortable in and why? How can we work for the common good of our neighbors in our community?
8. What friends or neighbors can we be praying for and serving practically?
