GROWING DEEPER

The book of Esther has been called the godless book because God never speaks and his name is never even mentioned, however, his hand of providence is behind everything. Why do we tend to assume that God isn't working if we don't see miraculous, flashy and extravagant displays of power?

What is God's providence, and what are some scriptures that illustrate this truth?

How can God's providence reassure us in the midst of difficulty or uncertainty? What are some examples in your life of times God was providentially working behind the scenes in ways you would only discover later?

Throughout church history, Esther has always been an example of great courage in the face of uncertainty. Read Esther 4:1-17 and discuss what Esther must have been thinking and feeling as she prepared to go before the king. In 4:13, Mordecai asks Esther to consider that God may have ordained her to be queen for such a time as this; to stand before the king and plead for her people. What is the relationship between God's providence and our responsibility? What unique opportunities do you have in the time, situation and relationships God has given you?

What risk was Queen Esther taking by approaching the king and how did she prepare for it? How does the story of Esther foreshadow the story of Jesus?

Queen Esther was willing to risk her life to save her people. If you have taken a risk to do what was right, please share it with your group. What fears often get in the way of moving forward with bold faith? Create a prayer list of areas where you need courage. What fears do you need rooted out of your heart? What opportunities do you have this week to walk in boldness?
