Read Matthew 4:1-4

How does the temptation of Jesus by the Devil clearly reveal the nature and reality of spiritual warfare? Why is understanding the reality of spiritual warfare so important? What is the danger of ignoring the existence of both spiritual evil and temptation? How can you become more aware of spiritual attacks and temptations? How are being tempted by the Devil and being tested by God related to one another? How does Satan attack you personally with the temptation of self-gratification?

Read Matthew 4:5-7

Have you ever experienced someone twisting scripture to justify their own sinful behaviors?

How are the Devil's temptations in your life always a test of your faith and not just your self-control?

In what kinds of circumstances do you most often question God's presence, care, power or love?

There are times in all of our lives when we are tempted to wonder if God cares about us; how can you combat those thoughts?


Read Matthew 4:8-11
