In Psalm 46:4-7 what are the six poetic insights that the psalmist gives about God that are helpful in the midst of great fear?

In Psalm 46:8-11 the psalmist encourages the readers to behold the works of God. What are some works of God in creation, salvation, and in your life circumstances that can encourage you in the midst of your fears?

What are some common fears in your life that you experience on a weekly basis? What effect does unaddressed fear have in your life? How is fear a matter of unbelief? What sort of responses do you normally have towards fear? Instead of denying our fears, how can we process them with God in prayer? Take some time to pray for each other and the fears that we're struggling with.
