

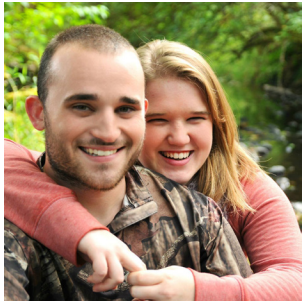


VOLUNTEER SPOTLIGHT
