# **GROWING DEEPER**

What are some of your favorite wedding experiences or memories? What is the strangest things you have ever seen happen at a wedding? Why are weddings so important?

What makes the Gospel of John different than the other gospels? Why did John write his gospel and what does its purpose tell us about why he structured the book the way he did, selecting only certain content (John 20:31)?

Read John 2:1-12 and discuss what initially jumps out to you in this story.

John calls Jesus' miracle a sign, but what is the purpose of this sign? What is the greater Kingdom reality the sign is pointing to? What does this miracle show us about the character of God? What does this miracle show us about the concern of God? What concerns and difficulties in your life do you need to bring to Jesus? How can you, like Mary, bring the difficulties and shame others are experiencing to Jesus?

The jars Jesus uses to perform the miracle were used for ritualistic and ceremonial cleaning. How do people in our contemporary society try to cleanse their feelings of sin and shame? What secular rites and rituals of purification are used to try to cleanse the conscience? How does Jesus' coming death not just forgive us but cleanse us? Why is a clear conscience so important to your spiritual vitality? How would you describe the effect that sin has on your conscience?


