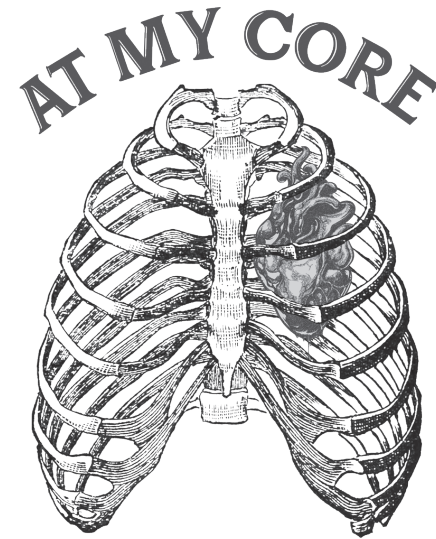


DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Read Romans 7:15-25. Can you relate to what Paul is saying? Do you feel torn at times between what you want to do and what you are doing? Where is our hope found during this struggle?
2. According to Philippians 2:2-13, God desires our salvation to impact every area of our lives. What does it look like to work out your salvation in every area of your life? What does Paul mean when he says that "it is God who works in you..."? How should that give you peace?
3. Read Philippians 1:6; how might this connect with Philippians 2:13?
4. I Timothy 4:7 tells us to "train ourselves for godliness." How can we train so that we might grow in Christ-likeness?
5. Discuss some of the benefits of growing in our sanctification and Christ-likeness:
 - Growing glorifies God
 - Growing verifies regeneration
 - Growing adorns truth
 - Growing grants assurance
 - Growing preserves us from the pitfalls of spiritual immaturity
 - Growing protects the cause of Christ from reproach
 - Growing produces joy and usefulness to Christ
 - Growing provides a witness to those without Christ
6. We often worry about all the things we want to do for God or accomplish in this world. How should knowing God is more concerned with completing the work in you than doing a work through you change how you think about what you "need" to do?
7. It is through sanctification that we increasingly reflect the image of Christ. How do you reflect Christ today; is it more than when you first became a believer?
