- 2. Every house is like its own kingdom, and certain household rules and expectations are common. What sorts of household rules do you have?
- 3. Have you ever unknowingly violated someone else's household rules?

### **Explore & Apply**

- 4. When you hear the word kingdom, what comes into your mind? Discuss why it is important to have a ruler, a realm, a people, and a place to have a kingdom. How would you explain the entire Bible as a conflict between two kingdoms? Which stories and verses would you use? How might this reality of the Kingdom minister to unbelieving family and friends? What sort of responses might you or have you received when talking about the Kingdom of God with Christians and with non-Christians?
- 5. How would you explain life inside the Kingdom of God? What sorts of ways can you and your family best represent the Kingdom of God to a watching world? What ways does our Christian faith need to shift from internal to external, from local to global and from us to everyone? What temptations do we experience when we step outside of the reign of God as our King?
- 6. If who you obey determines who is functionally ruling over you, then what sorts of "kings" and "kingdoms" exist in our culture today?
- 7. What specific ways can we be praying for God's Kingdom to come in our neighborhood, community, and city?
