1. How would you define peace? Why is peace so important to each of us? Read Isaiah 9:6 and discuss the different titles for Jesus and what they describe about his ministry.

Peace with God

- 2. Why does the issue of people being at peace with God matter? What must happen for us to be at peace with God? (Atonement, forgiveness, repentance, adoption, etc.)
- 3. What things are currently robbing your joy that you need to take to God and ask for forgiveness?

Peace with Ourselves

- 4. What disrupts your personal peace? Who is the first person you go to when something goes wrong?
- 5. Read Philippians 4:7-8 and talk about how you have experienced the peace that passes understanding in your life (if you have).

Peace with Others

- 6. Read Ephesians 2:14 and discuss the dividing lines and hostilities that exist between people in our culture.
- 7. How does Jesus' life, death and resurrection bring peace between very different people-groups?

8. What concerns and anxieties do you need to move from worry into worship by praying and releasing them? What is your next step to growing in peace? Where is God leading you? How can your group support you?
