

Beginning My Relationship with God

"This Good News tells us how God makes us right in his sight. This is accomplished from start to finish by faith. As the Scriptures say, 'It is through faith that a righteous person has life." Romans 1:17

How do you come to God in faith? It is as easy as A, B, C, and D.

A: Admit you need a Savior. You can't get to God on your own. You're a sinner. You've blown it. Heaven is perfect, and you're not.

B: Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved" (Acts 16:31a) Believe Jesus is who the Bible says he is, and trust him with everything you have.
