II. Discussion Questions

- 1. Jake started by talking about our relationship with work and the story we tell ourselves around it. How would you describe your relationship with work? What story do you tell yourself about it?
- 2. He used a quote by author Tish Warren that said, "Everyone wants a revolution. No one wants to do the dishes." What do you think this means, and how does it change your perspective on your job?
- 3. Read Genesis 2:15 together. This verse comes from before the fall, before sin and before conflict. This means that work is inherently a good thing and part of God's best for humanity. What does this mean for us today? How should this frame our understanding of work and the story we tell ourselves about it?
- 4. Thinking through the sorts of labor and work that fill your days, read 1 Peter 4:10. How is God already using your gifts to serve others, and how might He want to use them in new ways?
- 5. Jake closed by outlining three stories we should tell ourselves around work. They were:
 - 1. We need all of us
 - 2. God Designed you with gifts you shouldn't waste
 - 3. Work forces us to depend on God
