### Icebreaker Questions:

1. What's something small you've done for someone else that ended up meaning more to them than you expected?
2. If you suddenly had an extra free hour in your week, how would you most enjoy using it?

### LIFEgroup Lesson

1. Time, talent, and treasure are often described as the three resources we can offer to God's kingdom. Which of these do you find hardest to "take off the shelf?" What barriers or challenges tend to hold you back?
2. Can you recall a time when you witnessed God accomplish something significant even though the available resources seemed small or insufficient? What stood out to you about that experience?
3. Read **John 6:10–14**. As you imagine yourself in the story, do you relate more to the disciples who saw the limitations ("We don't have enough"), or to the boy who offered what little he had? What makes you identify with that perspective?
4. Sister Lemon's quote, 'If it ain't hard, it ain't God,' challenges the idea that following God should always be easy or convenient. Why is our first instinct to doubt God's presence if a situation feels hard or impossible? What might change in your life if you reframed big challenges as "God-sized opportunities" instead of dead ends?
5. In what area of your life do you sense God may be calling you to step out in obedience, trusting that He can use you for His glory?
