LIFEgroup Lesson

I. **OPEN SHARE** - What's one thing that stood out to you from the message?

II. **Discussion Questions**

1. In the sermon Bryan used Ephesians 1:7-10 to ask “What will I Become?”

Read Jeremiah 29:11. In Jeremiah we know that God already knows what we'll become.

Do you feel that knowing God already knows makes you feel better or makes you more stressed out in fear that you won't live up to God's expectations? Why?

- i. **Jeremiah 29:11 (ESV) “For I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord, plans for welfare and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope.”**
2. Bryan discussed being relational beings created by God for God. Hebrews 11:6 says that He rewards those who seek him. What are some of the benefits God has for us by being in relationship with Him?
 - i. **Possible answers may include: capacity to extend love, forgiveness, understanding, and compassion toward yourself and others will grow with His help.**
3. As Christians, we're supposed to find our identity in God. How do we know we've done that?
 - i. **Good question.**
 - ii. **When we begin finding our identity in Christ, we are essentially rejecting our identity in the world**
 - iii. **Romans 12:2 (NIV) “Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.”**
