Discussion Questions

1. In the message, Jake mentioned that Jesus asked many questions but answered relatively few. Why do you think Jesus often chose to teach this way?
2. A.W. Tozer said, *“What comes into our minds when we think about God is the most important thing about us.”* When you think about God, what thoughts or images come to mind?
3. Read **Matthew 16:21–23** together. Peter rebuked Jesus when he didn’t like what Jesus said would happen. When have you struggled to accept something, God allowed or that didn’t go the way you expected?
4. Think about the choices you made over the past week. If you drew two circles—one representing your beliefs and one representing your choices—how much would they overlap? What influenced where you would place them?
5. Jake shared the illustration of two ropes—one leading us closer to Jesus and the other pulling us in a less healthy direction. What are some things that can pull people away from Jesus, and how can we recognize when that is happening?
6. Jake talked about Peter realizing he needed **Jesus—and something more**. What do you think the “and something” might represent in your own life right now
