Ice Breaker Questions

2. Which Bible character do you think would be the worst roommate, and why?

Discussion Questions

1. “Memento vivere” translates to “you must first live” or “remember to live.” Jesus promised us an abundant life (John 10:10). What does purposeful living look like in your daily life?
2. Read 1 Peter 2:9 (KJV) aloud. In today’s culture, being called “peculiar” isn’t always positive. How does Peter’s use of “peculiar” reflect something meaningful or valuable for believers?
3. Pastor Jake spoke about how life is full of attachments, including empty attachments and being attached to Jesus. What is one “empty attachment” you feel led to release?
4. Pastor Jake said, “Your legacy will be a Who, not a what.” In what ways are your daily actions influencing others toward Jesus?
5. Read 2 Corinthians 4:8–10 (NLT) together. How can Christians respond to suffering in a way that reflects joy and points others to Jesus?
