Have someone read each of the verses that were highlighted in the message, and briefly discuss.

Is there an area that you feel God is speaking to you through this message?

FINAL THOUGHTS:

- SUMMARIZE the main idea of this message.

Would anyone like to share your thoughts about what we discussed today? How can we pray for you as a group?

Stages of Temptation:

E - Educate yourself about how the enemy works

- The devil will try to get you to believe and act on lies
- Jesus redirects His thinking to the Truth in scripture

I have nothing good in the future to look forward to:	God has good plans for me (Jeremiah 29:11)
