## Understanding 'Holy' August 21, 2016

"For I, the Lord, am the one who brought you up from the land of Egypt, that I might be your God. Therefore, you must be holy because I am holy."Leviticus 11:45 (NLT)

## What does <u>holy</u> mean?

Greek word: <u>qadowsh</u> Translation: <u>sacred</u> and <u>set apart</u> Main idea: God is <u>sacred</u> and is <u>set apart</u> from anything else that we know.

"It was in the year King Uzziah died[a] that I (Isaiah) saw the Lord. He was sitting on a lofty throne, and the train of his robe filled the Temple. Attending him were mighty seraphim, each having six wings. With two wings they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they flew. They were calling out to each other, "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of Heaven's Armies! The whole earth is filled with his glory!"
