Acts 2:46 - *“Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts.”*

1. When you think of “gathering” in a Christian context, what type of events come to mind?
2. Does the thought of Gathering in a Christian context bring on a feeling of excitement or more of a feeling of anxiety? Explain your answer.
3. Why do you think someone might say that gathering is necessary for spiritual growth and development?
4. What’s the greatest motivation that causes you to gather (if you do so regularly) or what’s the greatest hinderance to you being able to gather (if you don’t do so regularly)?
5. What next step can you take, right now, that will help maintain or increase your ability to gather with other Christ followers?

Philemon 6 - *“I pray that your partnership with us in the faith may be effective in deepening your understanding of every good thing we share for the sake of Christ.”*

3. What do you think holds people back from reaching more often (or at all)?

Pathways review:

Pathways is a discipleship initiative that will help Christ followers do three things:

1. Assess where we are spiritually
2. Guide us in practicing spiritual disciplines that will help me to grow
3. Help us measure our progress

We believe “If we walk the Pathways, we’ll become the virtues.”

What does the Bible say about Gathering?

Two areas we should think about Gathering

1. Gather at Coastal.

Reaching in Pathways

In Pathways, reaching is defined as “sharing the hope of Christ’s love through evangelism and outreach.”

“I pray that your partnership with us in the faith may be effective in deepening your understanding of every good thing we share for the sake of Christ.” Philemon 6 (NIV)

What does Reaching look like?

1. Know the Gospel Story
2. Be familiar with the Roman’s Road
3. Prepare YOUR story
4. Get involved in evangelism and outreach

- Commit to a more intentional approach to attend church every Sunday
- Commit to gathering in person on Sundays
- Commit to joining a LIFEgroup.
- Commit to leading / starting a new LIFEgroup.
- Commit to learning the Gospel Story (use RNM as a resource)
