2. Trabelus compared living in God's presence to walking with a dove resting on your shoulder, moving carefully and intentionally. What does practicing God's presence look like for you while you wait?
3. Is there a prayer or situation you are currently waiting on God for? How are you choosing to wait patiently and prayerfully in this season?
4. Read the following verse below that highlight God's promises; then share what stands out or encourages you from these promises.
  - Deuteronomy 31:6 *Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid or terrified because of them, for the Lord your God goes with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you.*
  - Romans 10:13 *for, "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."*
  - James 1:5 *If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you.*
