Public (100+ people)	Sermon on the Mount	Sunday Morning
Social (20-50 people)	Jesus and the 72	Men's & Women's Ministry
Personal (5-20 people)	Jesus and the 12	Life Groups
Intimate (2-3 people)	Jesus w/ Peter, James & John	Accountability Groups
