Evidence for the Resurrection of Jesus:

<u>Early</u> Accounts.

"When I was an atheist, the way that I would write off the resurrection is by saying it's a legend. Jesus was crucified in 33 A.D. and I used to believe that the New Testament writings about Jesus weren't written down until 50, 60, 100 years later. So you've got this huge gap of time. And certainly in that gap of time all kinds of legends and make believe and wishful thinking grew up and distorted what had actually happened so that when the New Testament was finally written it probably bears no resemblance to what actually had taken place. I used to believe that. But then I looked at the evidence. What I found was that scholars have discovered that the New Testament writings about Jesus were written much closer to the life of Jesus Christ than critics had once charged. In fact, they were written well within the lifetimes of eyewitnesses that would have corrected the information if it had been exaggerated or false."
